In order for their presentation to be considered for the AES 'Blue Fingers' Student Award, **students should submit their abstract to the ePoster session of SciX during the open call for abstracts**. When submitting their abstract students must select **the option regarding participation in the student AES poster competition in order to be eligible**. Please also send the following application materials to AES as instructed below. The AES section chairs, Dr. Wenwan Zhong (Univ. of California, Riverside) and Dr. Aliaksei Boika (Univ. of Akron), will coordinate the judging of the submitted applications. The ePoster of the winning student will be featured on the AES website.

1. This completed application form
2. The submitted abstract (350 word max) for the proposed presentation.
3. Two letters of nomination, one by the student's mentor. An explanation of the inventive and creative contributions by the student to the work should be included.
4. A copy of the candidate's résumé.
5. A copy of the candidate's graduate transcript.
6. Copies of reprints and/or preprints of authored or co-authored publications.
