Call for applications

The AES Student Award recognizes the most outstanding student paper submitted for the AES Annual Conference by a **graduate student at the time of application**. The award recipient **needs to be an AES member will receive financial support (\$500¹) to attend the AES Annual Conference**; the financial support can be used to cover registration, transportation, accommodations, and meals. In order for their presentation to be considered for the AES 'Blue Fingers' Student Award, **students should submit their abstract to the POSTER session of SciX during the open call for abstracts**. When submitting their abstract students *must* select the **option regarding participation in the student AES poster competition in order to be eligible**; the awardee will give a 20 minute oral presentation at the AES Annual Conference.

Please also send the application materials to AES as instructed below. Members of the AES Board as well as the session chairs for the conference, will coordinate the judging of the submitted applications. The awardee will be notified as soon as possible once the selection is made. The ePoster of the winning student will also be featured on the AES website.

1. This completed application form
2. A copy of the abstract submitted SciX for poster session
3. Two letters of nomination, one from the student's mentor. These letters should address the inventive and/or creative contributions by the student to the work to be presented.
4. A copy of the candidate's graduate transcript (does not need to be the official transcript)
5. The candidate's résumé
6. Copies of any publications or preprints of authored or co-authored publications (prior publications are not a requirement for the award)

¹ In the event of an all online conference, or if the awardee is unable to attend SciX in person, the amount of the award may be reduced to cover only the registration fees.
